Refer to the label photo and Stitch Abbreviations to assemble the kit. There are sufficient components in this kit to complete it as shown. Any alterations to the design will affect the yardage of yarn. Be sure to keep track of the stitches that the directions state. Due to production variations in materials, colors may vary slightly from the photograph on packaging.

ABBREVIATIONS:			
rnd(s) - round(s)	dc - double crochet	inc - increase(2 sc/st)	(36) - number of sts after each rnd
mr - magic ring	FLO - front loop only	dec - crochet 2 st together	
ch - chain	BLO - back loop only	sl st - slip stitch	FO - fasten off
sc - single crochet	st(s) - stitch(es)	x6 - repeat 6 times	

INSTRUCTIONS:

•Attach the stitch marker to the beginning stitch of each round. This will help keep an accurate count of stitches per round.

ICING-

- Rnd 1:** with pink yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)
- Rnd 2:** inc in each st around (12)
- Rnd 3:** (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x6 (18)
- Rnd 4:** (1 sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) x6 (24)
- Rnd 5:** (1 sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) x6 (30)
- Rnd 6:** (1 sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st) x6 (36)
- Rnd 7:** 1 sc in each stitch around (36)
- Rnd 8:** (1 sc in next 5 sts, inc in next st) x6 (42)
- Rnd 9:** (1 sc in next 6 sts, inc in next st) x6 (48)
- Rnd 10:** 1 sc in each stitch around (48)
- Rnd 11:** (1 sc in next 7 sts, inc in next st) x6 (54)
- Rnd 12 - 14:** 1 sc in each stitch around (54)
- Rnd 15:** (1 sc in next 7 sts, dec in next 2 st) x6 (48)
- Place eyes between rows 12 & 13, 5 stitches apart
- Rnd 16 & 17:** 1 sc in each stitch around (48)
- Rnd 18:** (sl st in the next st, 4 dc in the next st, sl st in next st) x16 (96)
- FO and leave a 20 inch yarn tail. Stuff the icing.

CUPCAKE HOLDER-

- Rnd 1:** with light brown yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)
- Rnd 2:** inc in each st around (12)
- Rnd 3:** (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x6 (18)
- Rnd 4:** (1 sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) x6 (24)
- Rnd 5:** (1 sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) x6 (30)
- Rnd 6:** (1 sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st) x6 (36)
- Rnd 7:** (1 sc in next 5 sts, inc in next st) x6 (42)
- Rnd 8:** (1 sc in next 6 sts, inc in next st) x6 (48)
- Rnd 9:** Working in BLO, 1 sc around (48)
- Rnd 10 - 14:** (BLO 1 sc in next st, Front Post sc in next st) x24 (48)
- Rnd 15:** (inc in the next BLO, Front Post sc in next st) x24 (72)
- Rnd 16:** (1 sc in the next 2 BLO, Front Post sc in next st) x24 (72)
- FO and leave a 2 inch yarn tail, weave the yarn tail inside the cupcake holder. Stuff the cupcake holder.

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CHERRY-

Rnd 1: with red yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x6 (18)

Rnd 4 - 6: 1 sc in each stitch around (18)

Rnd 7: (1 sc in the next st, dec in next 2 st) x6 (12)

Rnd 8: 1 sc in each stitch around (12)

Stuff the cherry.

Rnd 9: (dec the next 2 sts) x6 (6)

FO and leave a 12 inch yarn tail.

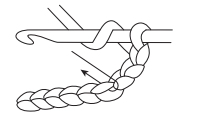
FINISHING:

1. Use the yarn tail on the icing to sew the icing to the cupcake holder. Knot the yarn on a close stitch and weave it in the icing, trim excess.
2. Pin the cherry to the top center of the icing. Use the yarn tail on the cherry to attach the cherry to the icing. Knot the yarn on a close stitch then insert the needle up through the center of the cherry exiting out the top center creating a stem. Trim the yarn to 1 inch.
3. Thread the needle with the embroidery floss (all 6 strands). Add the mouth, 1 row below the eyes. Refer to the cover photo as reference. Weave the floss in the icing, trim excess.

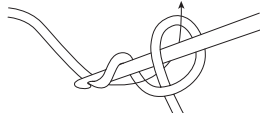

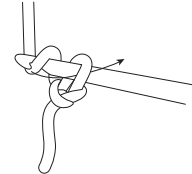
Single Crochet



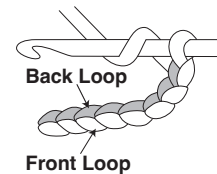
Double Crochet



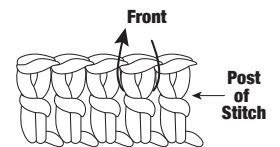
Magic Ring



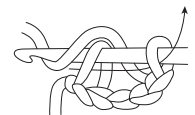
Chain



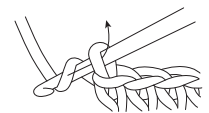
BLO and FLO
