

HD49610E "Sarah the Boba Tea" Amigurumi



Refer to the label photo and Stitch Abbreviations to assemble the kit. There are sufficient components in this kit to complete it as shown. Any alterations to the design will affect the yardage of yarn. Be sure to keep track of the stitches that the directions state. Due to production variations in materials, colors may vary slightly from the photograph on packaging.

ABBREVIATIONS:			
rnd(s)- round(s)	sl st- slip stitch	BLO- back loop only	x6- repeat 6 times
mr- magic ring	hdc- half double crochet	st(s)- stitch(es)	(36)- number of sts
ch - chain	dc- double crochet	inc- increase(2 sc/st)	after each rnd
sc- single crochet	FLO- front loop only	dec- crochet 2 st together	FO- fasten off

INSTRUCTIONS:

•Attach the stitch marker to the beginning stitch of each round. This will help keep an accurate count of stitches per round.

CUP TOP-

Rnd 1: with cream yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (1 sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) x6 (24)

Rnd 5: (1 sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) x6 (30)

Rnd 6: (1 sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st) x6 (36)

Rnd 7: 1 sc in each stitch around (36)

Rnd 8: (1 sc in next 5 sts, inc in next st) x6 (42)

Rnd 9: (1 sc in next 6 sts, inc in next st) x6 (48)

Rnd 10: 1 sc in each stitch around (48)

Rnd 11: (1 sc in next 7 sts, inc in next st) x6 (54)

Rnd 12: 1 sc in each stitch around (54)

Rnd 13: Working in FLO- (sl st in the next st, [1 hdc, 1 dc, 1

hdc in the next st], sl st in the next st) x 18

FO and weave in the end tail, trim excess.

STRAW-

Rnd 1: with light purple yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x3 (9)

Rnd 3: Working in the BLO, 1 sc in each stitch around (9)

Rnd 4 - 7: 1 sc in each stitch around (9)

Stuff the straw.

FO and leave a 6 inch yarn tail.

CUP-

Rnd 1: with light purple yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (1 sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) x6 (24)

Rnd 5: (1 sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) x6 (30)

Rnd 6: (1 sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st) x6 (36)

Rnd 7: (1 sc in next 5 sts, inc in next st) x6 (42)

Rnd 8: Working in BLO, 1 sc in each stitch around (42)

Rnd 9 - 11: 1 sc in each stitch around (42)

Rnd 12: (1 sc in next 6 sts, inc in next st) x6 (48)

Rnd 13 - 17: 1 sc in each stitch around (48)

Start stuffing the cup and continue as you go.

Rnd 18: (1 sc in next 7 sts, inc in next st) x6 (54)

Rnd 19 - 24: 1 sc in each stitch around (54)

Place the eyes between rows 18 & 19, 8 stitches apart.

FO, leave an 18 inch yarn tail.

BUBBLES (make 8)-

With dark purple yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6), sl st in the first st

FO and leave a 6 inch yarn tail.




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FINISHING-

- 1. Pin the straw to the top of the cup. With the straw yarn tail, attach the straw to the top of the cup. Knot the yarn on the underside of the top. Stuff the top and place on top of the cup.
- Use the yarn tail on the cup to attach the cup top to the cup using the back loops left from round 13 of the cup top. Add more stuffing as needed before you completey sew the top on. Knot the yarn on a close stitch. Weave the yarn in the cup and trim excess.
- Pin the bubbles randomly around the bottom of the cup, between rounds 10 - 14. Use the yarn tail on the bubbles to attach them to the cup. Knot the yarn on the bubble and weave the yarn in the cup. Trim excess.
- 4. Use the embroidery floss (all 6 strands) to add eyelashes. Refer to the cover photo as reference.
- Use the embroidery floss (all 6 starnds) to add a mouth, 2 rows below the eyes. Use the cover photo as reference for placement. Weave floss in the cup, trim excess.
