

Refer to the label photo and Stitch Abbreviations to assemble the kit. There are sufficient components in this kit to complete it as shown. Any alterations to the design will affect the yardage of yarn. Be sure to keep track of the stitches that the directions state. Due to production variations in materials, colors may vary slightly from the photograph on packaging.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

# CAKE BOTTOM/SIDES (working from the bottom up the sides)-

•The first stitch of each row is below the starting chain. Row 1: with cream yarn ch 2, sc in second ch from the hook, sc in the next st, ch 1, turn (1) Row 2: inc in the next st, ch 1, turn (2) Row 3: sc across, ch 1, turn (2) Row 4: inc in the next 2 sts, ch 1, turn (4) **Row 5:** sc across, ch 1, turn (4) Row 6: inc in the next st, 1 sc in the next 2 sts, inc in the next st, ch 1, turn (6) **Row 7 & 8:** sc across, ch 1, turn (6) Row 9: inc in the next st, 1 sc in the next 4 sts, inc in the next st, ch 1, turn (8) Row 10 & 11: sc across, ch 1, turn (8) Row 12: inc in the next st, 1 sc in the next 6 sts, inc in the next st, ch 1, turn (10) Row 13 & 14: sc across, ch 1, turn (10) Row 15: inc in the next st, 1 sc in the next 8 sts, inc in the next st, ch 1, turn (12) **Row 16 - 18:** sc across, ch 1, turn (12) Row 19: inc in the next st, 1 sc in the next 10 sts, inc in the next st, ch 1, turn (14) Row 20 - 22: sc across, ch 1, turn (14) Row 23: 1 sc in the next 14 sts. Continue to work down the side of the cake, 1 sc in the next 22 sts, inc in the last st. Working up the other side, 1 sc in the next 22 sts, ch 1, turn (60)

Row 1: Working in BLO, 1 sc in each st across, ch 1, turn (46)
Row 2 - 8: sc across, ch 1, turn (46)
Change to pink yarn.
Row 9 & 10: sc across, ch 1, turn (46)
Change to cream yarn.
Row 11 - 19: sc across, ch 1, turn (46)
Place eyes on the side of your choice between rows 15 & 16, 5 stitches apart.
FO, weave in the yarn tails and trim ends.

#### CAKE END-

With pink yarn, working on row 23 of the bottom of the cake

•The first stitch of each row is below the starting chain. **Row 1:** working in BLO, ch 1, sc across, ch 1, turn (14) **Row 2 - 20:** sc across, ch 1, turn (14)

**Row 21:** sl st in next st, (sl st in next st, 3 dc in next st, sl st in next st) x4, sl st in next st (22) FO and leave a 24 inch yarn tail.

#### CAKE TOP-

With pink yarn. **Row 1 - 23:** same as cake bottom (rows 1 - 23) FO and leave a 36 inch yarn tail.



### FINISHING-

- Fold the end of the cake up and pin to the sides of the cake. Use the cake end yarn tail to sew the end of the cake to the left side of the cake going down the edge. Run the yarn tail across the back bottom pink row on the inside of the cake. Continue to sew up right side of the cake using the remaining yarn tail. Secure the yarn on a stitch with a knot. Weave the remaining yarn tail inside of the cake.
- 2. Pin the cake top to the top edge of the cake sides/end, making sure to match up the pointed end of the cake top and the pointed end of the cake sides. Using the yarn tail from cake top, sew the cake top to the sides/back going in each stitch. Leave the end of the cake next to the ruffle open. Add the stuffing. Sew the opening closed. Secure the yarn tail on a close stitch and weave the yarn tail inside the cake. Trim excess.
- Thread the needle with the black embroidery floss (all 6 strands) and add the mouth between the eyes, 1 row down. Refer to the cover photo as reference for placement. Weave floss in cake, trim excess.
- 4. Thread the needle with a 12 inch piece of cream yarn. Stitch 6 Straight Stitches on top of the cake for sprinkles. Each sprinkle is about 1/2 inch long. Spread them out randomly. Refer to the cover photo as needed for reference. Weave the yarn tails inside the cake, trim excess.


