Refer to the label photo and Stitch Abbreviations to assemble the kit. There are sufficient components in this kit to complete it as shown. Any alterations to the design will affect the yardage of yarn. Be sure to keep track of the stitches that the directions state. Due to production variations in materials, colors may vary slightly from the photograph on packaging.

ABBREVIATIONS:			
rnd(s) - round(s)	HDC - half double crochet	sl st - slip stitch	x6 - repeat 6 times
mr - magic ring	DC - double crochet	st(s) - stitch(es)	(36) - number of sts after each rnd
ch - chain	FLO - front loop only	inc - increase(2 sc/st)	FO - fasten off
sc - single crochet	BLO - back loop only	dec - crochet 2 st together	

INSTRUCTIONS:

•Attach the stitch marker to the beginning stitch of each round. This will help keep an accurate count of stitches per round.

TREE-

Rnd 1: with green yarn work 4 sc in a mr (4)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (8)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in each st around (8)

Rnd 4: (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x4 (12)

Rnd 5: (1 sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) x4 (16)

Rnd 6: (1 sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) x4 (20)

Rnd 7: Work the stitches in this order to create the scallop. Working in FLO, (sl st in the next stitch, HDC & DC in the next stitch, DC & HDC in the next stitch, sl st in next stitch) x5 (20) (slip stitches do not count)

Rnd 8: working in BLO, (1 sc in the next 4 sts, inc in the next st) x4 (24)

Rnd 9: (1 sc in next 5 sts, inc in next st) x4 (28)

Rnd 10: (1 sc in next 6 sts, inc in next st) x4 (32)

Rnd 11: (1 sc in next 7 sts, inc in next st) x4 (36)

Rnd 12: (1 sc in next 8 sts, inc in next st) x4 (40)

Place eyes between rows 10 & 11, 6 stitches apart.

Stuff the tree and continue as you go.

Rnd 13: Work the stitches in this order to create the scallop. Working in FLO, (sl st in the next stitch, HDC & DC in the next stitch, DC & HDC in the next stitch, sl st in next stitch) x10 (40) (slip stitches do not count)

Rnd 14: working in BLO, (1 sc in the next 9 sts, inc in the next st) x4 (44)

Rnd 15 & 16: 1 sc in each stitch around (44)

Rnd 17: working in the BLO, (1 sc in the next 20 sts, dec in next 2 sts) x2 (42)

Rnd 18: (1 sc in next 5 sts, dec next 2 sts) x6 (36)

Rnd 19: (1 sc in next 4 sts, dec next 2 sts) x6 (30)

Rnd 20: (1 sc in next 3 sts, dec next 2 sts) x6 (24)

Rnd 21: (1 sc in next 2 sts, dec next 2 sts) x6 (18)

Rnd 22: (1 sc in the next st, dec next 2 sts) x6 (12)

Rnd 23: (dec next 2 sts) x6 (6)

FO, leave a 6 inch yarn tail. Use the yarn tail to sew the hole closed.

Weave yarn in the tree to hide end. Set aside for now.

TREE TRUNK-

Rnd 1: with brown yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (1 sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) x6 (24)

Rnd 5: working in BLO, 1 sc in each stitch around (24)

Rnd 6: 1 sc in each stitch around (24)

Stuff the tree trunk.

FO, leave a 8 inch yarn tail. Set aside for now.

STAR-

Rnd 1: with yellow yarn work 5 sc in a mr (5)

Rnd 2: (sl st, HDC, sl st) all in the next stitch x5

FO, leave a 6 inch yarn tail. Set aside for now.

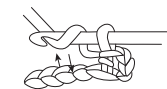
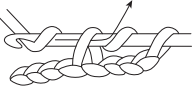
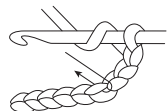
FINISHING:

1. Pin the tree trunk to the bottom of the tree. Use the yarn tail on the tree trunk to sew the tree trunk to the tree. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the tree, trim the end if needed.
2. Use the yarn tail on the star to attach the star to the top of the tree. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the tree, trim the end if needed.
3. Attach yellow yarn to the back of the tree at the top near the bottom of the star with a sl st. Chain 20, FO. Attach the end of the chain to the tree next to the starting chain creating a hanger.
4. Thread the needle with the embroidery floss (all 6 strands). Refer to the cover photo to add the mouth details.

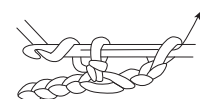
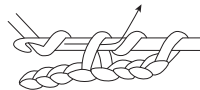
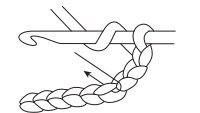

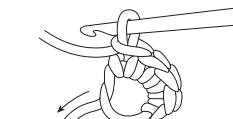
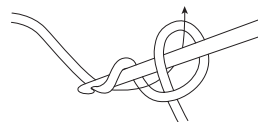
Single Crochet



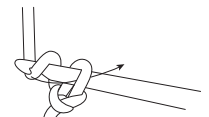
Half Double Crochet



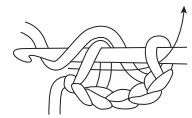
Double Crochet



Magic Ring

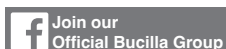


Chain
