

Refer to the label photo and Stitch Abbreviations to assemble the kit. There are sufficient components in this kit to complete it as shown. Any alterations to the design will affect the yardage of yarn. Be sure to keep track of the stitches that the directions state. Due to production variations in materials, colors may vary slightly from the photograph on packaging.

ABBREVIATIONS:		
rnd(s) - round(s)	sl st - slip stitch	x6- repeat 6 times
mr- magic ring	st(s) - stitch(es)	(36)- number of sts after each rnd
ch - chain	inc- increase(2 sc/st)	FO- fasten off
sc - single crochet	dec- crochet 2 st together	

INSTRUCTIONS:

•Attach the stitch marker to the beginning stitch of each round. This will help keep an accurate count of stitches per round.

HEAD-

Rnd 1: with white yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6) Rnd 2: inc in each st around (12) Rnd 3: (1 sc in the next st, inc in next st) x6 (18) Rnd 4: (1 sc in the next 2 sts, inc in next st) x6 (24) Rnd 5: (1 sc in the next 3 sts, inc in next st) x6 (30) Rnd 6: (1 sc in the next 4 sts, inc in next st) x6 (36) Rnd 7 & 8: 1 sc in the next 13 sts, change to peach yarn, sc in the next 10 sts, change to white yarn, sc in the next 13 sts (36) Rnd 9 & 10: 1 sc in the next 14 sts, change to peach yarn, sc in the next 8 sts, change to white yarn, sc in the next 14 sts (36) Rnd 11: 1 sc in the next 15 sts, change to peach yarn, sc in the next 6 sts, change to white yarn, sc in the next 15 sts (36) Rnd 12: (1 sc in the next 4 sts, dec next 2 sts) x6 (30) Rnd 13: 1 sc in each stitch around (30) Place eyes between rows 9 & 10, 4 stitches apart. Start stuffing the head and continue as you go. Rnd 14: (1 sc in the next 3 sts, dec next 2 sts) x6 (24) Rnd 15: (1 sc in the next 2 sts, dec next 2 sts) x6 (18) **Rnd 16:** (1 sc in the next st, dec next 2 sts) x6 (12) Rnd 17: (dec next 2 sts) x6 (6)

FO, leave a 6 inch yarn tail. Use the tail to sew the hole closed. Weave yarn into head to hide end. Set aside for now.

NOSE-

Rnd 1: with peach yarn work 5 sc in a mr (5) Rnd 2: inc in each st around (10) Rnd 3: (dec next 2 sts) x5 (5) Stuff the nose. FO, leave a 6 inch yarn tail. Set aside for now.

BEARD-

Rnd 1: with white yarn work 5 sc in a mr (5) Rnd 2: 1 sc in each stitch around (5) Rnd 3: inc in each st around (10) Rnd 4: (1 sc in the next st, inc in next st) x5 (15) Rnd 5: (1 sc in the next 2 sts, inc in next st) x5 (20) Rnd 6: 1 sc in each stitch around (20) Rnd 7: (1 sc in the next 3 sts, inc in next st) x5 (25) Rnd 8: (1 sc in the next 4 sts, inc in next st) x5 (30) Rnd 9: (1 sc in the next 5 sts, inc in next st) x5 (35) Rnd 10: (1 sc in the next 6 sts, inc in next st) x5 (40) Rnd 11 & 12: 1 sc in each stitch around (40) Rnd 13: (dec next 2 sts x2, 1 sc in the next 16 sts) x2 (36) FO, leave a 12 inch yarn tail. Set aside for now.

EYEBROW (make 2)-

Rnd 1: with white yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6) Rnd 2 - 4: 1 sc in each stitch around (6) FO, leave a 8 inch yarn tail. Fold the eyebrow flat. Set aside for now. Do not stuff.

MUSTACHE HALVES (make 2)-

Rnd 1: with white yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)
Rnd 2: (1 sc in the next 2 sts, inc in next st) x2 (8)
Rnd 3: (1 sc in the next 3 sts, inc in next st) x2 (10)
Rnd 4: 1 sc in the next 8 sts, dec next 2 sts (9)
Rnd 5: 1 sc in the next 7 sts, dec next 2 sts (8)
Rnd 6: (1 sc in the next 2 sts, dec next 2 sts) x2 (6)
Rnd 7: (1 sc in the next st, dec next 2 sts) x2 (4)
FO, leave a 8 inch yarn tail. Set aside for now. Do not stuff.

HAT-

Rnd 1: with red yarn work 5 sc in a mr (5) Rnd 2: inc in each st around (10) Rnd 3 - 6: 1 sc in each stitch around (10) Rnd 7: (1 sc in the next st, inc in next st) x5 (15) Rnd 8 & 9: 1 sc in each stitch around (15) Rnd 10: (1 sc in the next 2 sts, inc in next st) x5 (20) Rnd 11: (1 sc in the next 3 sts, inc in next st) x5 (25) Rnd 12: 1 sc in each stitch around (25) Rnd 13: (1 sc in the next 4 sts, inc in next st) x5 (30) Rnd 14: (1 sc in the next 4 sts, inc in next st) x6 (36) Change to white yarn. Rnd 15: (1 sc in the next 8 sts, inc in next st) x4 (40) Rnd 16 - 19: 1 sc in each stitch around (40) FO, leave a 12 inch yarn tail. Set aside for now. Do not stuff.


HAT POM-POM-

Rnd 1: with white yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)
Rnd 2: inc in each st around (12)
Rnd 3: 1 sc in each stitch around (12)
Start stuffing the pom-pom.
Rnd 4: (dec next 2 sts) x6 (6)
FO, leave a 6 inch yarn tail. Set aside for now.

FINISHING:

- 1. Pin the nose to the face between the eyes. The top of the nose should be level with the center of the eyes. Use the yarn tail to sew the nose to the face. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the head, trim the end if needed.
- 2. Pin one of the eyebrows to the face over one of the eyes. The eyebrow should be on half of the white yarn and half on the peach yarn. Use the yarn tail to sew the eyebrow to the face. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the head, trim the end if needed. Repeat for the other eyebrow.
- 3. Place the head in the beard and pin in place around the head just below the nose. Use the yarn tail on the beard to sew the beard to the head. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the head, trim the end if needed.
- 4. Pin one of the mustache halves to the face under the nose. The rounded edge should be under the nose. Use the yarn tail to sew the mustache half to the face. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the head, trim the end if needed. Repeat for the other mustache half.
- 5. Use the yarn tail on the pom-pom to the sew the pom-pom to the tip of the hat. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the hat, trim the end if needed.
- 6. Place the hat on the head and pin in place. The last several rounds of the hat should roll up a little to create the hat trim. Use the yarn tail to sew the hat to the top of the head. Bend the hat tail over to the side slightly. Use a small piece of red yarn to stitch the hat bend in place. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the head, trim the end if needed.
- Attach red yarn to the top of the hat with a sl st. Chain 20, FO. Attach the end of the chain to the hat next to the starting chain creating a hanger.
