

Bucilla HD49678E "Billy the Bear" Amigurumi



Refer to the label photo and Stitch Abbreviations to assemble the kit. There are sufficient components in this kit to complete it as shown. Any alterations to the design will affect the vardage of varn. Be sure to keep track of the stitches that the directions state. Due to production variations in materials, colors may vary slightly from the photograph on packaging.

INSTRUCTIONS:

·Attach the stitch marker to the beginning stitch of each round. This will help keep an accurate count of stitches per round.

HEAD-

Rnd 1: with brown yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (1 sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) x6 (24)

Rnd 5 - 11: 1 sc in each st around (24)

Place eyes between rows 7 and 8, 5 sts apart. Start stuffing the head, continue as you go.

Rnd 12: (1 sc in next 2 sts, dec next 2 sts) x6 (18)

Rnd 13: (1 sc in next st, dec next 2 sts) x6 (12)

Rnd 14: (dec next 2 sts) x6 (6)

FO and leave a 6 inch yarn tail. Use the yarn tail to sew the hole closed. Weave the yarn in the head, trim excess away.

MUZZLE-

RND 1: with brown yarn work 5 sc in mr (5)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (10)

Rnd 3: (1 sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st) x2 (12)

FO and leave a 6 inch yarn tail. Stuff the muzzle. Details will be added later.

EAR (make 2)-

Rnd 1: with brown yarn work 4 sc in mr (4)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (8)

Rnd 3: (1 sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) x2 (10)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in next 8 sts, dec next 2 sts (9)

FO and leave a 6 inch yarn tail. Do Not Stuff.

BODY-

Rnd 1: with Brown yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (1 sc in next 8 sts, inc in next st) x2 (20)

Rnd 5: (1 sc in next 9 sts, inc in next st) x2 (22)

Rnd 6 - 8: 1 sc in each st around (22)

Start stuffing the body, continue as you go.

Rnd 9: (1 sc in next 9 sts, dec next 2 sts) x2 (20)

Rnd 10: (1 sc in next 8 sts, dec next 2 sts) x2 (18)

Rnd 11: (1 sc in next st, dec next 2 sts) x6 (12)

FO, and leave a 12 inch yarn tail.

ARM (make 2)-

Rnd 1: with brown yarn work 4 sc in mr (4)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (8)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in each st around (8)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in next 6 sts, dec next 2 sts (7)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in next 5 sts, dec next 2 sts (6)

Rnd 6: 1 sc in each st around (6)

FO and leave a 6 inch yarn tail. Stuff the lower half of the arm only.

LEG (make 2)-

Rnd 1: with brown yarn work 6 sc in mr (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: (dec next 2 sts) x2, 1 sc in next 8 sts (10)

Rnd 4: 1 sc in each st around (10)

Rnd 5: (1 sc in next 3 sts, dec in next 2 sts) x2 (8)

Rnd 6: 1 sc in each st around (8)

FO and leave a 6 inch yarn tail. Stuff the leg.

TAIL-

Rnd 1: with brown yarn work 4 sc in mr (4)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (8) Rnd 3: (dec next 2 sts) x4 (4)

FO and leave a 6 inch yarn tail. Stuff the tail.

HEART-

•With pink yarn work a mr with (ch 3, 2 hdc, 1 dc, ch 1, 2 hdc, ch 3, sl st)

•Pull yarn tail of the ring tightly to close up the heart. FO and leave a 6 inch yarn tail.

FINISHING-

- Pin the head to the top of the body. Use the yarn tail to attach the head to the body, secure with a knot. Weave the remaining yarn tail through the body, trim excess away.
- Pin the muzzle to the head between of the eyes. The top of the muzzle should be level with the center of the eyes. Use the yarn tail to attach the muzzle to the head, secure with a knot. Weave the remaining yarn tail through the head, trim excess away.
- 3. Using the black yarn, add the nose details. Refer to the cover photo for placement. Weave the remaining yarn tail through the head, trim excess away.

- 4. Pin the ear to the side of the head starting on row 4 and going down to row 7. Use the yarn tail to attach the ear to the head, secure with a knot. Weave the remaining yarn tail through the head, trim excess away. Repeat for the other ear.
- 5. Pin the arm to the side of the body, 1 row down from the neck. Make sure it is in line with the ears. Use the yarn tail to attach the arm to the body, secure with a knot. Weave the remaining yarn tail through the body, trim excess away. Repeat for the other arm.
- 6. Pin the leg to the bottom of the body, starting at row 2. Make sure it is in line with the ear and arm. Use the yarn tail to attach the leg to the body, secure with a knot. Weave the remaining yarn tail through the body, trim excess away. Repeat for the other leg.
- 7. Pin the tail to the body between the legs, about 4 rows up from the center. Use the yarn tail to attach the tail to the body, secure with a knot. Weave the remaining yarn tail through the body, trim excess away.
- 8. Pin the heart to the middle of the body. Use the yarn tail to attach the heart to the body, secure with a knot. Weave the remaining yarn tail through the body, trim excess away.
