Refer to the label photo and Stitch Abbreviations to assemble the kit. There are sufficient components in this kit to complete it as shown. Any alterations to the design will affect the yardage of yarn. Be sure to keep track of the stitches that the directions state. Due to production variations in materials, colors may vary slightly from the photograph on packaging.

rnd(s) - round(s)	inc - increase(2 sc/st)	(36) - number of sts after each rnd
mr - magic ring	dec - crochet 2 st together	FO - fasten off
sc - single crochet	BLO - back loop only	
st(s) - stitch(es)	x6 - repeat 6 times	

INSTRUCTIONS:

•Attach the stitch marker to the beginning stitch of each round. This will help keep an accurate count of stitches per round.

HEAD-

- Rnd 1:** with green yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)
 - Rnd 2:** inc in each st around (12)
 - Rnd 3:** (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x6 (18)
 - Rnd 4:** (1 sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) x6 (24)
 - Rnd 5:** (1 sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) x6 (30)
 - Rnd 6:** (1 sc in next 14 sts, inc in next st) x2 (32)
 - Rnd 7 - 11:** 1 sc in each stitch around (32)
 - Rnd 12:** 1 sc in the next 8 sts, (1 sc in the next 2 sts, dec in the next 2 sts) x4, 1 sc in the next 8 sts (28)
 - Rnd 13:** 1 sc in the next 8 sts, (1 sc in the next st, dec in the next 2 sts) x4, 1 sc in the next 8 sts (24)
- Turn the head so the stitch marker is toward you. The opposite end is the chin. Use a straight pin the mark the center of the chin between rows 8 & 9. Count 10 stitches to the right of the center straight pin and insert one eye. Count 10 stitches to the left of the center straight pin and insert the other eye. The eyes should be in-line on either side of the head. Adjust if needed then secure in place with the backs. Start stuffing and continue as you go.
- Rnd 14:** dec the next 2 sts, 1 sc in the next 6 sts, (dec the next 2 sts) x4, 1 sc in the next 6 sts, dec the next 2 sts (18)
 - Rnd 15:** 1 sc in each st around (18)
 - Rnd 16:** (1 sc in next 5 sts, inc in next st) x3 (21)
- FO, leave a 12 inch yarn tail.

BODY-

- Rnd 1:** with green yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)
 - Rnd 2:** inc in each st around (12)
 - Rnd 3:** (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x6 (18)
 - Rnd 4:** (1 sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) x6 (24)
 - Rnd 5:** (1 sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) x6 (30)
 - Rnd 6:** (1 sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st) x6 (36)
 - Rnd 7 - 10:** 1 sc in each stitch around (36)
 - Rnd 11:** 1 sc in the next 9 sts, (1 sc in the next 4 sts, dec in the next 2 sts) x3, 1 sc in the next 9 sts (33)
 - Rnd 12:** 1 sc in the next 9 sts, (1 sc in the next 3 sts, dec in the next 2 sts) x3, 1 sc in the next 9 sts (30)
 - Rnd 13:** dec the next 2 sts, 1 sc in the next 7 sts, (1 sc in the next 2 sts, dec the next 2 sts) x3, 1 sc in the next 7 sts, dec the next 2 sts (25)
 - Rnd 14:** 1 sc in each st around (25)
 - Rnd 15:** 1 sc in the next 8 sts, (1 sc in the next st, dec in the next 2 sts) x3, 1 sc in the next 8 sts (22)
 - Rnd 16:** dec the next 2 sts, 1 sc in the next 20 sts (21)
- Stuff the body.
FO, leave a 24 inch yarn tail.

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ARM (make 2)-

Rnd 1: with green yarn work 5 sc in a mr (5)

Rnd 2 & 3: 1 sc in each stitch around (5)

Stuff the arm.

FO, leave a 6 inch yarn tail.

LEG (make 2)-

Rnd 1: with green yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: Working in the BLO, 1 sc in each stitch around (12)

Rnd 4: (1 sc in next 3 sts, inc in the next st) x3 (15)

Stuff the leg.

FO, leave a 10 inch yarn tail.

SPIKES (make 6)-

Rnd 1: with yellow yarn work 4 sc in a mr (4)

Rnd 2: (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x2 (6)

Rnd 3: (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x3 (9)

Rnd 4: (1 sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) x3 (12)

Stuff the spike.

FO, leave a 8 inch yarn tail.

BELLY-

Rnd 1: with cream yarn work 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: inc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (1 sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) x6 (24)

Remove the stitch marker and sl st in that st. FO, leave a 24 inch yarn tail.

TAIL-

Rnd 1: with green yarn work 4 sc in a mr (4)

Rnd 2: (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x2 (6)

Rnd 3: (1 sc in next st, inc in next st) x3 (9)

Rnd 4: (1 sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) x3 (12)

Rnd 5: (1 sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) x3 (15)

Rnd 6: (1 sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st) x3 (18)

Stuff the tail.

FO, leave a 12 inch yarn tail.

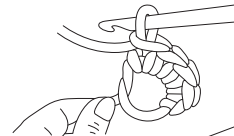
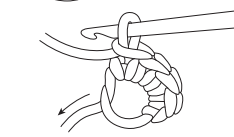
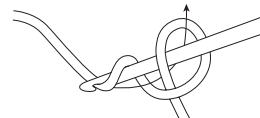
FINISHING-

1. Place the head on the body (match the front of the head with flat side of the body, rounded side is the back). Pin in place if needed. Use the yarn tail on the body to sew the head to the body going through each stitch all the way around. Use the yarn tail on the head to add extra stitches if needed. If not needed, weave yarn in head and trim excess. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the body, trim excess.
2. Pin the belly to the front of the body between rows 6 & 14. Use the yarn tail to sew the belly to the front of the body. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the body, trim excess.
3. Pin the arm to the side of the body on rows 15 & 16, about 7 stitches apart. Use the yarn tail to sew the arm to the body. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the body, trim excess. Repeat for the other arm.
4. Pin the tail to the back of the body in the middle. The bottom edge of the tail is on row 6 and the top of the tail is on row 10. Use the yarn tail to sew the tail to the body. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the body, trim excess.
5. Pin the spike to the back of the body covering 2 rows of the top of the tail (make sure the spike is in the center of the back). Use the yarn tail to sew the spike to the body. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the body, trim excess. Attach the remaining 5 spikes (one at a time), end to end going up the center of the back toward the head.
6. Pin the foot to the bottom of the body between rows 4 & 8. Use the yarn tail to sew the foot to the body. Knot the yarn on a stitch and weave the yarn in the body, trim the end if needed. Repeat for the other foot. The middle of the feet are about 7 stitches apart.

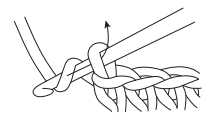

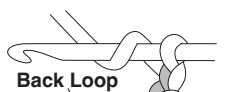
Single Crochet
