


INSPIRATION PAINTING



SHADED OBJECTS

Shading gives an object dimension. Shading is the the process of adding value to create the illusion of form, space, and light in a drawing. Value refers to the visible lightness or darkness of a color. This is easiest to see when creating art that is black, white, and gray and using highlights, midtones, and shadows.


Once you have drawn the object(s), decide from what direction your light source is coming from. If the light is coming from the right, your shadow will be on the left. If the light is coming from the left, your shadow will be on the right. See Figure 1.





